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WHAT WE KNOW

Teachers matter for student life prospects

Teacher quality is the most important in-school factor influencing student academic success.

Too few students indicate they want to teach

In a recent poll, only 4% of students indicated interest in becoming an education major.

Many teachers grew up where they teach

More than 60% of teachers work within 20 miles of where they went to high school.

Lesson Structure

Lesson structure

- Bellringer:

Allow review of the previous day's lesson or preview content of the current lesson.

- Direct and guided instruction:

Provide gradual release through direct instruction and student practice.

- 45-minute lessons:

Allow flexibility for varying school scheduled across the state.

- Student guides:

Provide structure for students to participate in lesson activities.

- Student practice:

Provide regular opportunities for students to practice evidence-based strategies.

Debrief:

Provide closure of the lesson and an opportunity to reinforce key concepts.

- Exit tickets:

Provide daily formative assessments. The teacher may choose to count exit tickets as part of a student's grade.



Scope and Sequence Guiding Questions

For all:

- How do the courses work together to build student understanding?
- What common connections are there between course curricula?
- Where do you anticipate student misconceptions or questions?

If you have taught the courses before:

- How does this compare to how you have taught this class in the past?
- What might be challenging about implementing these scopes and sequences?

If you have NOT taught the courses before:

- What are you most excited about teaching? What will your students most enjoy?
- What might be challenging about implementing the courses?
